



HEALTH CERTIFICATE CLIENT PROTOCOLS

When making your appointment at 101 Pet Vet, please specify exactly where you will be traveling. The client care specialist will make the appointment for you based on where you are traveling and how long it will take to fill out the health certificate. Things you will need to bring to your appointment should include the following:

1. You and your pet.
2. Addresses and phone numbers of your current address and the address where you will be traveling to.
3. Name and address and phone number of persons receiving your pet upon arrival.
4. Proof of current rabies including multiple proof of Rabies if necessary. Does not need to be original, a copy will suffice and long as it has the doctor's signature. The rabies certificates must include manufacturer, lot number and serial number.
5. Please be on time to your appointment, as these certificates are time consuming and require the doctor's time to fill out the forms.
6. Please bring paperwork of proof of any other vaccines such as DA2PP and Bordetella, fecal tests, heartworm, etc. FVRCP, FELV etc.
7. Please indicate prior to exam if your pet has a microchip, we will scan and record number as well.
8. If you cannot obtain the proper paperwork prior to the appointment, we will have to reschedule. Please bring with you or email to us at info@101petvet.com.
9. Please check with your airline prior to your appointment and flight to make sure you have all necessary paperwork or any other documentation.
